### This unique cafe

and bar is a space that transforms the mood of visitors and enriches them with the feeling of an intimate private garden, as the name suggests. The design brief was to utilize the views while crafting a restaurant space serried by the city, in the middle of the chaotic street that typically busts with traffic. The backyard is planned in a manner that enables a leisure experience while sitting on the terrace or next to a window, as the former of the space is articulated by means of plants and trees which not only augment the natural ambience but also reduce the noise, generated from the street activities nearby and in-vicinity.

The overall design objective was to go beyond the conventional approach and utilize things in the backyard that one discards as a waste. The furniture is created out of crates and barrels and the stools are made of industrial metal and reclaimed wood, which captures the essence of a backyard. The accessories include old bottles used as lighting, which add further to the rustic and raw element of the space. The random placing

of antique mirrors creates a dynamic reflection, which adds a unique look to the interiors.

The designer's vision was realized by constructing large glass windows, allowing a fusion of the exterior landscape and the interiors. These windows bring in plenty of natural light during the day and a fresh feeling of being at outdoors with the plants and trees lit up at night. 🌿
